Join the fun; sign up for our Junior Golf Sessions. Sessions are open to boys and girls between the ages of 11-14, of all ability levels. We focus on basic golf skills and etiquette allowing kids to play a comfortable round of golf with new and old friends, on their own! Sessions include eight weeks of lessons and eight rounds of golf beginning Wednesday, June 12th and ending August 7th, EXCLUDING July 3rd.

An emphasis will be placed on honesty, integrity, sportsmanship, rules and proper etiquette of golf, and most importantly having fun! All golfers must have his/her own set of golf clubs. Need clubs? Take advantage of our Free Kids Clubs that we offer. Ask Clubhouse Attendant for more information.

Registration forms can be found online at stcloudmac.com, in the clubhouse, and at the main business office. Register as soon as possible as there is a limited number of spaces available. All openings are filled on a first come – first serve basis.



The Sessions are for kids who have little or no experience with golf and for kids who have had some experience playing golf in the past. Players will be divided up based on their ability. The golfers will receive lessons from St. Cloud Cathedral's Junior High Golf Coach, Bill Schmit. During the sessions, golfers will work on their skills on and around the practice putting/chipping green, on a practice tee box, and on the golf course. We will cover basic rules, behavior, & etiquette, full swings with irons & woods, pitching, chipping & putting. Sessions will be from 11:00am-1:00pm. Fee is \$85/golfer.



There will be a lunch served following a shotgun start tournament on August 7th.
